



Classroom Behavior Log

If your child is working towards meeting particular behavior goals, it's important to have a record of his or her specific behaviors over time.

If you both agree that a behavior log would be useful, discuss whether rewards or punishments would be appropriate in response to your child's behavior. For example, has the teacher found it useful to immediately reward students' good behavior in the classroom, or should you reward your child at the end of the week? Every child is different, so you should use the classroom behavior log as a way to promote an ongoing dialogue between you, your child, and the teacher.

WHO SHOULD USE THIS TOOL?

This tool is meant to be used by your child's teacher to track his or her classroom behavior during the course of a week. You should discuss the results of the log with the teacher, so you can come up with the best solution for targeting specific behaviors.

HOW SHOULD IT BE USED?

The Classroom Behavior Log can be given to your child's teacher to update daily, as a record of your child's behavior in class.
